MASS INTENTIONS


There are proximity 4,500 families registered in our church (data before the outbreak of COVID-19). Therefore, anyone can request a Mass on Tuesdays or Wednesdays – these are multiple intentions. The intentions are not accepted over the phone.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION - June 2nd, 2024

All parishioners are invited to participate in the Eucharistic Procession on the Solemn Feast of Corpus Christi (the Body and Blood of Christ) next Sunday.

In Canada, the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is observed on the Sunday following the Holy Trinity Sunday. It was established as a feast for the Universal Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264 as a doctrinal and prayerful response to heretical teaching about the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

The Corpus Christi procession serves as a public display of our Catholic faith in the real and enduring presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, and as a prolongation of the celebration of the Mass.

St. Margaret Mary faith community has a longstanding tradition of conducting the outside Corpus Christi procession. The parish fell away from the practice during COVID-19 when churches were closed, or gatherings were limited.

The Corpus Christi procession includes beautiful prayers and hymns, the reading of a Eucharistic Gospel and Benediction at four Altar locations. Members of various organizations, such as C.W.L. and Knights of Columbus take part in it, carrying their banners.

Particularly, the recent First Communion Children will benefit from this act of devotion to Our Lord in the Eucharist. They will be able to walk alongside their parents and family members in the procession scattering flower petals.

The clergy of Hamilton Diocese will also participate in the procession. What a blessing!

The way of the Procession:

1.Immediately following 11 am Mass, there will be the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

The procession will take us out the front entrance onto the sidewalk of Idlewood Ave. We will proceed left toward Brentwood Ave. **The First altar** will be located by the Parish sign on Brentwood Dr. After prayers and adoration (which will take place at each altar), the faithful will proceed along the sidewalk to the corner of Brentwood Dr and Wildwood Ave.

2.**The Second altar** will be at the corner on the wall of the St. Margaret Mary School Gym.

3.The procession will move along Wildwood Ave, entering the school yard. **The Third altar** will be on the wall of the school at the far end of the yard.

4.We will proceed through the parking lot to **the Fourth altar** which will be situated by the garage. All participants will return into the church for the final prayers and solemn benediction to the four corners of the world. A permit is not needed if we stay on church property and on the sidewalks.

Light refreshments will be served in the Parish Hearth Room following the closing prayers. We are asking parishioners for donations of home baking. Please bring them to the Parish Hall before the Mass.

First Communicants in formal dress will scatter flower petals on the processional route. If you have flowers to offer, kindly bring them to the rectory or to the church.

I invite you to join our Parish Community to honour the Lord on the Feast of Corpus Christi, by participating in this solemn profession of our faith through this traditional procession. It is an opportunity for us to be witnesses of Christ's love for us and to all to grow in our faith.

I strongly believe that a public procession will bring forth many blessings and spiritual fruits for our parish community and the broader community. St. Margaret Parish will be blessed by this strong display of faith in the Eucharistic Lord. Let us allow Christ, present in the Blessed Sacrament, to leave His temple and go forth to visit and bless our households.
