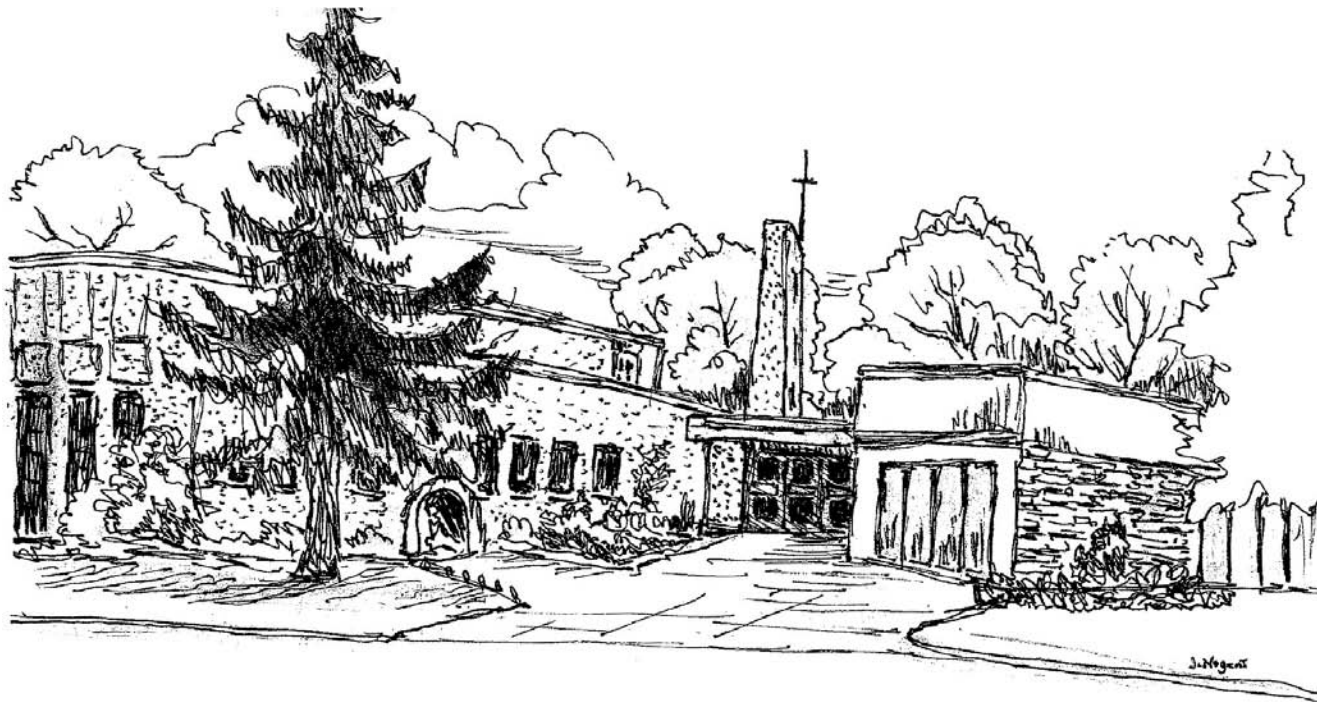

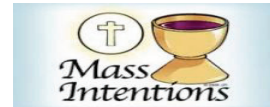
## **WHEN LIFE CHANGES: GRIEF RELIEF (PART ONE):**

## **A SEASON OF WAITING, HOPE, AND RENEWAL**

**The First Sunday of Advent** marks the beginning of a new liturgical year and the start of the Church's annual journey toward Christmas. It is a season filled with quiet expectation, joyful hope, and spiritual renewal, a time to prepare our hearts to welcome Christ not only in the celebration of His birth, but also in His coming again at the end of time. The word **Advent** itself comes from the Latin *adventus*, meaning "coming" or "arrival." It invites us to pause, to watch, and to ready ourselves for the presence of God who enters our world in love.

Advent has a twofold character. In its first weeks, the Church's readings and prayers focus on the final coming of Christ in glory. They call us to vigilance, conversion, and hope in the promise that God's kingdom will one day be fully revealed. The Gospel for the First Sunday of Advent often carries a tone of urgency, Jesus tells His disciples to "stay awake" and "be ready," for they do not know the hour when the Son of Man will come. This watchfulness is not meant to instill fear, but to awaken faith: we are called to live each day in readiness, grounded in the assurance that God's purposes are unfolding even when we cannot see them.

As Advent progresses, the focus shifts gently toward the first coming of Christ—His birth in Bethlehem. The purple or violet color of the season reflects both penitence and hope. Like Lent, Advent is a time of spiritual preparation, but its tone is more joyful than somber. The Advent wreath, with its four candles, is a beloved symbol of this journey. Each candle represents a week of waiting, and as the light increases, so does our anticipation of the Light of the World.

Entering into this season means embracing a spirit of simplicity and reflection amid the noise of modern life. The world around us rushes toward Christmas with shopping, busyness, and distraction, but the Church calls us to a different rhythm—to slow down, to listen, and to prepare inwardly. Advent invites us to cultivate silence, to pray with Scripture, and to renew our relationships with God and others. It is a time to ask: Where in my life do I need Christ to

come anew? What parts of my heart are waiting for His healing and peace?

This season also reminds us that waiting is not passive. Advent waiting is active, filled with faith and love. We wait as people who know that God is faithful, that His promises are sure. Each act of kindness, forgiveness, or generosity becomes a way of preparing the manger of our hearts for Christ's presence.

As the First Sunday of Advent dawns, the Church invites us to begin again—with hope. The Lord who came once in humility will come again in glory, and even now, He comes to us in every moment of grace. To enter Advent well is to open our eyes to this coming and to make room for Christ, who is Emmanuel—God with us—now and forever.
